By signing this permit, the signee acknowledges that he/she has read and is familiar with Fort Rucker Regulation 215-1 (hunting, fishing, and trapping regulations), location of traps, responsible personnel for trap, and receipt of trap, as well as any and all State of Alabama laws and regulations regarding the trapping/ hunting of feral pigs. By accepting this permit, the permittee agrees to abide by all state and local laws and ordinances. It is also the responsibility of the permittee to verify daily, the availability of training areas with Range Operations. Procedures detailed in FR 215-1, Appendix G must be followed for entry and trapping activity in training areas. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of the permittee to report trapping activity on a monthly basis to the DPW Natural Resources Branch Biologists or Chief.

Under no circumstances will live hogs/pigs be removed from the trap and/or transported to any other location.

Any non-compliance to the rules and regulations of this permit or violation of any State or Fort Rucker regulations, laws or ordinances, will result in revocation of the privileges stated in this permit and may also result in State and Federal prosecution.
